

Rowan County Republican Party By-Laws

B. COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

1. *Membership*

In accordance with Article III, B, 1. of the North Carolina Republican Party Plan of Organization The Rowan County Republican Executive Committee shall be composed of the following:

- a. The elected officers Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, the 10 Members –at-Large
- b. The Finance Chairman, appointed by the Chairman
- c. The President of any chartered Rowan County Republican Women’s Club, Republican Men’s Club, Young republican, College Republican Club
- d. The immediate past County Chairman. All other living past County Chairmen shall be ex-officio non voting members, while remaining residents of the county, whose numbers shall not be included in the determination of a quorum.
- e. The Rowan County Precinct Chairmen and Vice Chairmen as voting members and shall not effect a quorum.
- f. All current Rowan County Republicans duly elected to a partisan office and reside in Rowan County as Ex-officio members with voting rights and shall not affect a quorum.
- g. All officers of the 6th & 12th Congressional District Executive Committee elected by the District Convention who reside in Rowan County.
- h. All officers of the State Central Committee elected by the State Convention or by the State Executive Committee who reside in Rowan County.

2. *Vacancies*

- a. The Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Finance Officer, and Member at Large seat shall be considered vacant if said member is absent for three (3) scheduled meetings of the Executive Committee meeting within the County Convention year without notifying the Secretary with a reasonable excuse. All non-quorum members are required to attend 2 meetings per convention year to retain an active status.
